<p><b>Job Purpose:</b> To operate the plant</p> <p><b>Duties:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learn and operate all processes associated with the ethanol production plant</li> <li>• Learn and operate DCS (computer control system) for the plant</li> <li>• Follow standard operating procedures for plant start-up, shut down, cleaning, batching and operations</li> <li>• Do quality control tests on product streams; record/input results accurately and appropriately</li> <li>• Respond to collected data and make adjustment to optimize plant operation</li> <li>• Keep plant facilities clean using shovels, brooms, squeegees, etc.</li> <li>• Keep operators coming on shift briefed on what has happened and what is supposed to be done during the next shift</li> <li>• Responsible for notifying Plant Shift Supervisor of any production problems</li> <li>• Complete any and all tasks assigned by the Plant Shift Supervisor and Production Manager</li> <li>• Work closely and communicate with other departments (lab, maintenance, shipping/receiving)</li> <li>• Comply with all safety, environmental and other regulatory compliance programs and procedures. Use appropriate/required PPE.</li> </ul> <p><b>Skills/Qualifications/Requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Experience in production plants is a plus but not necessary</li> <li>• Experience with operating a forklift, manually opening valves, and taking samples</li> <li>• Hard working self-motivated individuals</li> <li>• Must be able to climb ladders and steps, walk on hard surfaces for long periods of time, and lift up to 60 pounds</li> <li>• Must be able to work at heights, and be able to adapt to a 12-hour workday while also meeting call-in requirements as needed</li> <li>• Shift work – 2 to 3, 12 hour on/off shifts each week, <b>3 day weekend every other week</b>, rotating from nights to days every 4 weeks</li> </ul>
